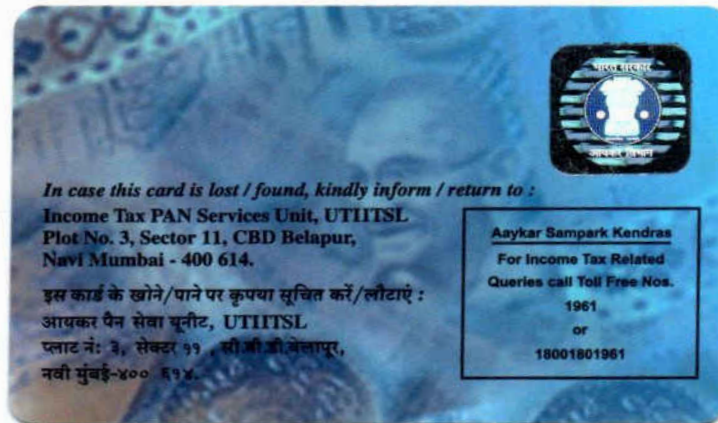

The Board of Trustees shall hold a sum of Rupees 1,000/- (Rupees One Thousand Only), this day paid to them and all funds, other movable or immovable properties and incomes thereof which may hereinafter be received by the Board of Trustees from time to time as Gifts, Donations, Grants, Subscription or otherwise for the purpose of the Trust and the Trust fund shall vest in the Trustees jointly.





4. The first founder member of International Valari Federation (ISC) and founder trustees shall retain their positions in the trust during their life time.

That the objectives of the Trust shall be wholly for the public and charitable purpose and incomes shall be applied for the same and accumulated in India wholly for public and charitable purposes without prejudice to generality of provisions aforesaid and the following shall be deemed to be the principal objectives of International Valari Federation (IVF):

- c. To develop such skills and values in them with which they become responsible and productive citizens of a modern, secular and technological nation.
- d. International Valari Committee-IVF is a International umbrella organization for all Valari sports, for all National Valari Associations (NSAs) & State Valari Associations (SSA)
- e. International Valari Federation-IVF& its members supports all United Nations & their agencies
- f. International Valari Federation – IVF& its members promotes all Olympic and Non-Olympic sports.

- g. - l. To encourage all Valari individuals, Universities, educational institutions, educational authorities, and Valari institutions can connect in professional communication in the field of flexible Valari sport.
- m. In pursuance of the said objects a sum of Rs.1000/- (Rupees One Thousand only) herein after called the Trust Fund is paid by the author of the trust irrevocably and the trustees have accepted and not hold on behalf of the trust to carry on aims and objects of the trust and the trustees for hereby undertake to hold the assets that have been given and that may be hereafter given to them or that they may come in to their hands as such trustees upon trust and subject to the provisions herein contained.

s. The objects and activities of the trust shall be carried throughout thenations. The trust will not function in the nature of conducting business activity and not for the purpose of profits.

t. The trust having their own following organizations and have approved its rules and regulations, office bearers to run smooth functioning of the offices of these organizations;

a. INDIAN VALARI SPORT ASSOCIATION (IVSA)

b. TAMILNADU VALARI SPORT ASSOCIATION (TVSC)

1.The trust shall power to receive any voluntary contribution whether in cash, aid, scholarship, equipments, clothes, books, magazines, literatures, food, medicines, scriptures, sports, equipments, scientific and educational equipments for research or in kind from any person from any source, whomsoever, whether by way of donation, legacy from India or abroad.


2.The founder of the trust Dr.Thiyagu Nagaraj shall be the first managing trustee and shall hold office life. Thereafter managing trustee shall nominate his successors to the office of managing trustee. If he fails to nominate, the board of trustees shall appoint one of the trustees or any competent person from outside the Board of Trustees as Managing Trustee.

III. POWERS OF THE MANAGING TRUSTEE

a) In order to fulfil the above mentioned objects of the Trust and to carry on such other activities as are incidental thereto: and to acquire movable and immovable properties from government; well -wishers or others and to receive and administers funds from or through any agency in any part of the world for charitable and religious work and also collect funds and administer the same.

IV CONSTITUTION OF THE TRUST

a. The Trust shall be irrevocable.

b. The Trust shall be governed by BOARD OF TRUSTEES.

The Board of Trustees shall consist of all the trustees, the number shall always be not less than two and more than seven.

c. The author of the Trust **Mr. THYAGU NAGARAJ**


shall be the first Managing Trustee and shall hold office for life.

After the Managing Trustee ceases to be Trustee by retirement or otherwise, the vacancies on the Board of Trustee shall be filled in by a majority of the Board of Trustees.

d. The First Board of Trustees are including Managing Trustee shall hold office for life. Any additional trustees appointed the office of the additional trustees be three years. They may be reappointed for the further period on invitation by the Managing Trustee. They all be liable to retire on the expire of the said term of three years unless they are reappointed for further period through the letter of invitations given to them.

- f. The Trust shall help assist and serve all people without discrimination as to colour, sex religion, caste, creed language or any other cause.

V. POWERS TO INVEST

- a. To purchase or acquire by lease or in any other manner any movable and immovable property of any kind considered by the trustee to be useful for the objects of the trust.
- b. To sell, lease, alienate, mortgage, change, pledge, hypothecate or otherwise deal with properties of the trust as the board may deem fit.
- c. To enter into contracts with any person or body for any purpose which are beneficial to the trust.



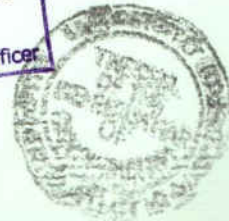


- d. To open or close one or more bank accounts for the trust with any bank as prescribed by the Income –Tax Act 1961, as the board of Trustees may deem fit and deposit money of the trust in such accounts and to give instructions to the bankers as to operate thereon. The Bank Account shall be operated jointly in the name of the Trust by Managing Trustee and Trustee. However they may delegate this powers to others, if situation warranted.
- e. To invest the funds of the trust in accordance with provisions of section 11(5) read with section 13(1) (d) of Income Tax Act.
- f. To employ persons necessary or useful for carrying out the objects of the trust on such terms and conditions as they may deem fit.
- g. To borrow any money from any person firm company bank government or any other body for any of the purpose of the trust on such terms as the trustees may deem fit and withor without furnishing securities and mortgage property or assets of the trust to secure repayment of any money so borrowed.
- h. To do all acts and deeds or things which are lawful, necessary incidental and conducive to the attainment of the objects of the trust.
- i) The Managing Trustee shall be the Chief Executive Officer who shall be in charge of day to day affairs of the trust.

j. The Board of Trust shall have power to draw, make, accept, discount negotiate, execute and encash cheques and bills of exchange and other negotiable instruments. He is entitled to institute, conduct or defend all suits and legal proceedings for and on behalf of the trust and to receive, serve of summons and processes for and on behalf of the Trust and to sign pleading, plaint, vakalats, statements and affidavits, for and on behalf of the Trust in respect of any proceedings before any court of law or other authority.

k. The Managing Trustee shall discharge all statutory obligations including filing of Income tax returns etc. If necessary and represent the Trust in all proceedings including Courts of Law.

VI. MEETING OF THE BOARD

a. Meeting of the Board of Trustees shall be held at least once in a year but any number of other Meetings may be held as and when considered necessary.


b. A Minute Book shall be kept by the Trustees. All proceedings of all the meetings of the Board of Trustees shall be entered in the Minute Book. and shall be signed by the chairman of the meeting at the conclusion thereof.

c. The Board of Trustees shall as its annual general meeting consider and approve the annual accounts, budget, proposals, annual report and the matters brought before it by any Trustee.

d. In addition to the annual general meeting the board may meet from time to time. The meeting shall be convened by the Managing Trustee.

- e. Two members of the Board shall constitute QUORUM.
- f. The Managing Trustee shall preside over the board meetings including annual general meetings as the Chairman.
- g. Every action taken by the board of Trustees shall be by a simple majority of the members present and voting. In the event of an equal divisor of votes, the Chairman of the board of Trustees shall have a casting vote in addition to his vote as Trustee.
- h) The Managing Trustee may invite others interested in the work of the Trust to attend the meetings of the board, but they shall not be entitled to vote thereat.

VII. ACCOUNTS AND AUDIT

- a) Regular and correct accounts of the trust, its funds receipts and expenditure shall be maintained.
- b) The financial year of the trust shall be from 1st April to 31st March of the following year. On the 31st March of every year a General Accounts shall be taken for all the assets and liabilities of the Trust and an Income and Expenditure account for the whole year and Balance sheet as on 31st March shall be prepared and shall be passed by the Trustees.
- c. The trustees shall appoint a Chartered Accountant to audit the accounts of the Trust and the audited statements of accounts shall be placed before the board for its consideration and approval.

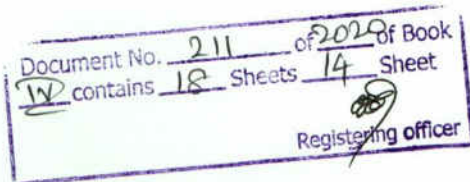
d. The income and funds of the trust will solely be utilized towards the objects and no portion of it will be utilized for payment to the trustees by way of profit, dividend, interest, etc.

VIII. BANK ACCOUNT



A BRIEF HISTORY OF VALARI GOD OF TRADITIONAL

A valari (Tamil: வளரி) is a thrown wooden or iron weapon used primarily by the Tamil people of the Indian subcontinent^[1] They come in both returning and non-returning varieties. The valari is used for protecting cattle from predators, and for war and hunting. Valari or Valai thadi (translates to Bent Stick) or throwing stick is a sharp crescent-shaped weapon, which was an ancient hunting weapon of the Tamil people. The weapon might have come into existence by the 'Sangam Age' (a vital period in the history of South India – constitutes between 300 BC and 200 AD). The weight of this curved weapon (usually made of wood or iron). is balanced in the middle and men trained in using Valari held it by the lighter end. It is then hurled with great force to bring down predators threatening the cattle or to hunt small game (animal hunted for food) in one stroke. Valari is often compared with hunting boomerang of the Australian aborigines. In Edgar Thurston's 'Caste and Tribes of Southern India', the deadly weapon is said to be vital part in the household of Southern Tamil Nadu's Kallan and Maravan tribes. The name 'Valari' has however become obsolete or forgotten, after the total dominion of British colonial forces. In 1801, British brought arms act which banned the use of weapons like Valari. The ban came into existence, especially after the British forces witnessed the deadly nature of these weapons in the Polygar or Palaiyakkarar Wars. The Palaiyakkarars, experts in throwing Valari, stood up to the gun-toting colonial forces. The weapon thrown from quite a distance whizzed at breakneck speed like missiles, bringing down slew of English men.

Colonel James Welsh of British East India Company has given detailed account of the Poligar wars in his journal 'Military reminiscences: A journal of nearly forty years' active service in the East Indies'. He mentions 'Chinna Maruthu' (famous ruler of Sivaganga), 'an affable man' and as the first man to have shown him how to throw the spear and Valari. James Welsh visited Chinna Maruthu (he writes down the name as 'Cheena Murdoo') in

1795 and few years later, he was part of the forces which had a single goal to hunt him down ('This same man (Maruthu), I was afterwards destined by the fortune of war, to chase like a wild beast' writes James Welsh). Many British colonels who served in the Polygar wars and other historians considers 'Valari' as significant or surprising part of this early Indian revolt against the British forces. Let's now take a brief look into the historical background of Polygar wars.

The Madurai Nayak dynasty, which came under the rule of Vijayanagara Empire, succeeded the ancient Tamil kingdom known as 'Pandya Dynasty' and after brief dominion of Sultan dynasty. The rule of Madurai Nayaks is said to have commenced around 1529. The Nayak dynasty was well renowned for administrative reforms, resurgence of ancient Temples (Madurai Meenakshi Temple partly destroyed by the Mohammedans was re-constructed in 1569), and for its unique architectural style and artistic achievements. The Nayaks, later appointed a class of military and administrative people, known as 'Palaiyakkarar' or 'Polygar' or 'Poligar'. Those appointed rulers between 16th and 18th century in southern Tamil Nadu paid fixed tributes to Nayak kings and reserved special troops for immediate military services. The Polygars expanded the irrigation projects, forts, etc, initiated by the Pandya kingdom.

The reign of Nayaks faced decline between the early and mid 18th century [by 1693 Madurai became feudatory for the emperor of Delhi – the Mughals, and later in 1752 the city was leased to Mohammad Yusuf Khan aka Maruthanayagam Pillai; this warrior was supported by British and Arcot Nawab to suppress Polygars, which resulted in small wars. He administered Madurai County for small period until a dispute with the colonial rulers. Marudhanayagam was hanged on 15 October, 1764 in Madurai by the British].

Even after the end of Madurai Nayaks, the Polygars stood their ground against British East India Company. Veerapandya Kattabomman, Uyyalawada Narsimha Reddy, Dheran Chinnamalai, and Puli Thevar were some of the notable Polygars who revolted against the colonial forces. By March 1799, the Polygars of the former Tirunelveli Kingdom (in South Tamil Nadu) – led by Kattabomman Nayak of Panchalankurichi Palayam – openly rebelled against the British. The Polygar Wars extended up to 1805 and it was the first large-scale rebellion against British control. It predates the Sepoy Mutiny of 1857 (or the Indian Rebellion of 1857). And, it is pretty evident that historians have always given less importance to the Polygar Wars. After grueling battles in the jungles and fort, British eventually won

over the Polygars and brought huge chunks of Tamil Nadu territories under its total control. The British hanged renowned Palaiyakkarar Kings and shunned many others to notorious Andaman Island prisons (the brutal end to Polygar system was later replaced with the Zamindari system).

‘Valari’ is now seen as one of the symbols, eulogizing the stiff resistance of South India against British East India Company. After banning this weapon in 1801, British government announced incentives for those who handed over the weapons and took stiff determined to abolish the weapon. At least 15,000 valaris were said to be confiscated. Most were immediately destroyed and few were transported to British museums (Liverpool, Fitzwilliam museums, etc). Tamil writer Venkatasan (of the Sahithya Academy Award winning historical novel ‘Kaval Kottam’), one who has done researches on this weapon, mentions in a Tamil article that he discovered hundreds of Valaris in a temple in Kovilankulam (a village near Madurai). The weapon is offered to the local deity (one of the last reminiscent of the ancient Tamil Culture).





VALARI GRADE REGULATION

Introduction: All IVF National Federations have the authority to request IVF diplomas for grades up to and including 8th black belt grade provided that the candidate has fulfilled the requirements to age and interval since last grading prescribed by IVF rules. Those wishing IVF diplomas for their grade up to and including 8th black belt grade must request these through their National Federation. For any grade above this, it is up to the National Federation to issue higher Dan for their accomplishments on the national level – but these grades are not homologated by IVF. In exceptional cases the IVF EC may on its own initiative award a grade above 8th black belt grade for outstanding contribution to Valari and the IVF, but by rule IVF is not issuing IVF black belt grades above 8th black belt based on recommendations or requests by NFs or individuals.

1. The Valari Grade System

- a) The Valari Grade system is based on recognition of personal development as practitioners, technicians, instructors and exponents of Valari. For Grades higher than 8th Black Belt the rank is recognition of the person's contribution to Valari beyond personal development.
- b) International Valari Federations (IVF) may only give, or certify, Grades for members of their own National Federation.
- c) 1st to 8th Black Belt will be issued by IVF approved National body
- d) 9th to 10th Black Belt will be issued only by IVF Executive Committee.

2. Origin of Belt: Yellow, Orange, Green, Blue, Brown and Black, the colours of belts denote student development, skills and experience. However, contrary to popular belief, using colored belts to denote rank or ability in martial arts. The systematic use of belt colour to denote rank was first used in India especially in Tamilnadu. The following colours used in the Valari Grades:

3. The Referee (நடுவர்-Natuvar) Grading System

- a) The Referee Grading system is based on recognition of personal development as practitioners, technicians, instructors and exponents of Valari.
- b) International Valari Federations (IVF) may only have rights to give, or certify referee seminar for members and each country national body will get written permission from IVF.
- c) There are only two categories of Referee Grades within the IVF:

1. *Chief Referee*
2. *Referee*

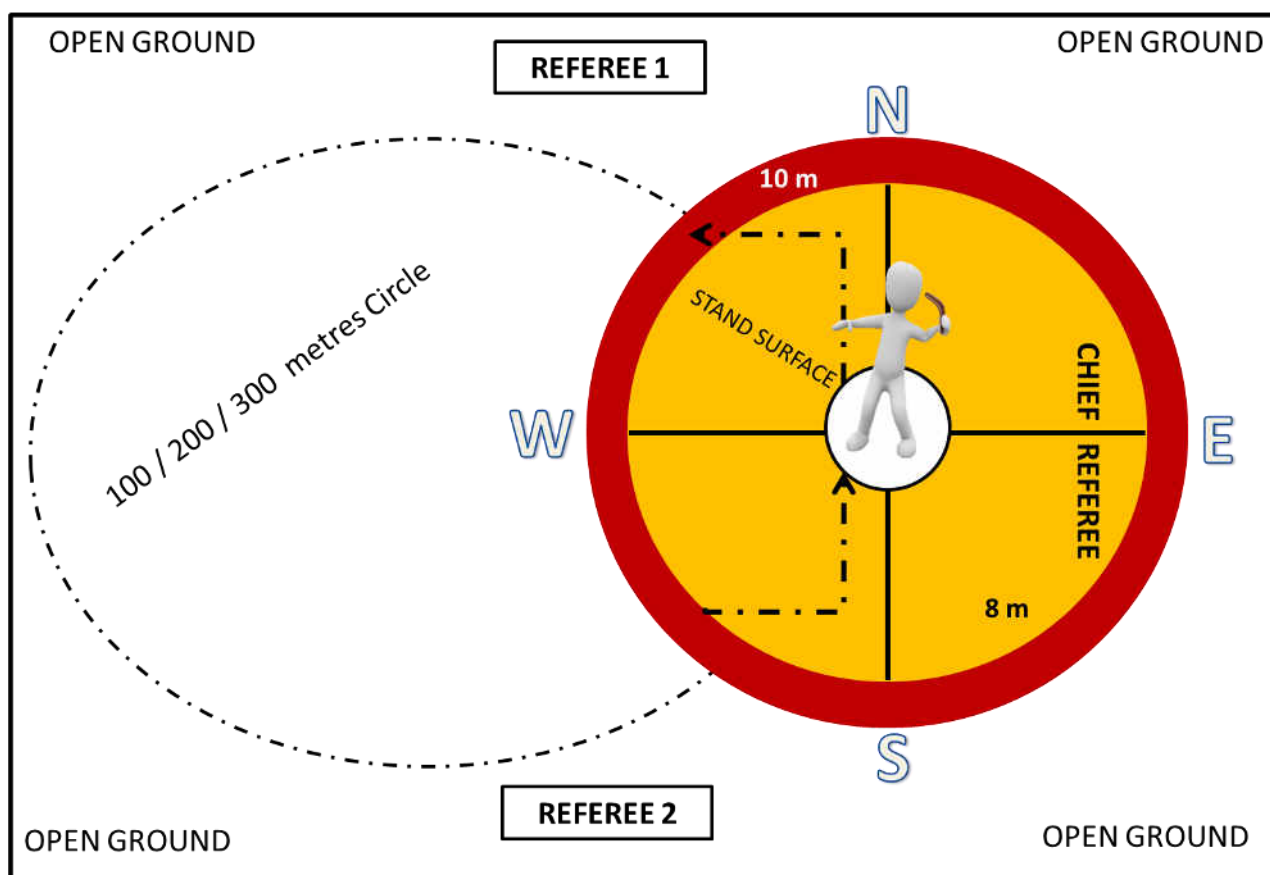

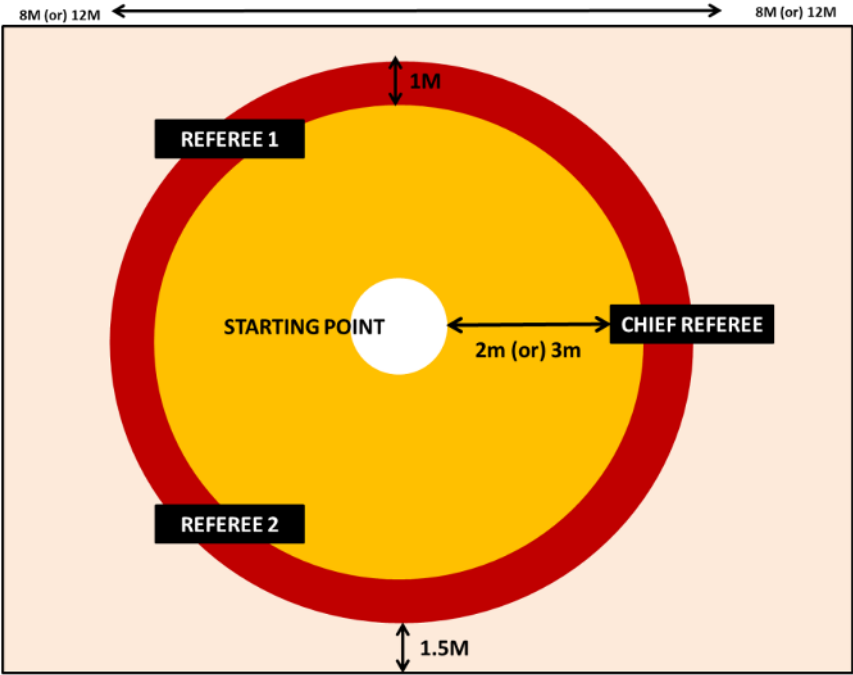

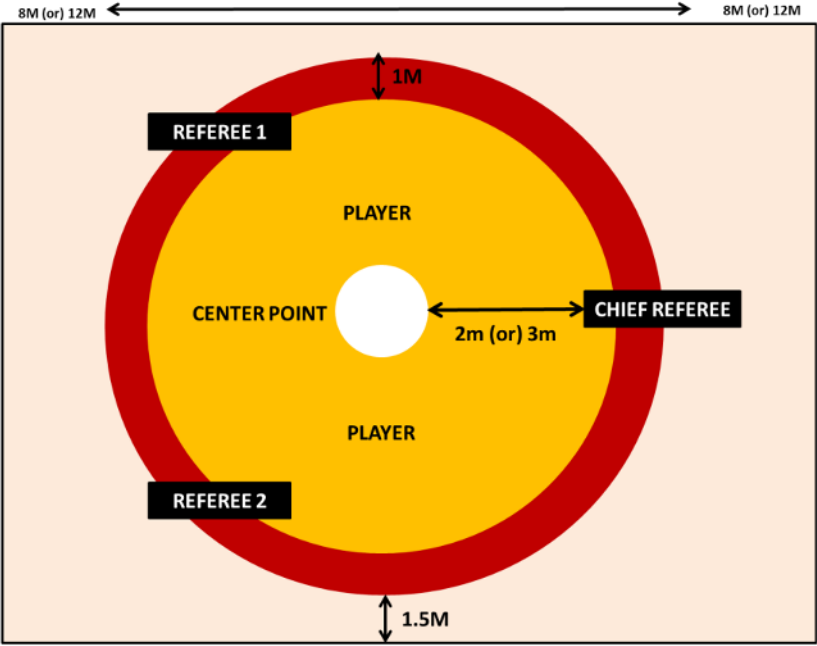

- Age wise/Weight Wise/Grade wise competition will be conducted (i.e. Yellow to Orange, Green to Brown, and Black Belt all grade).

Articles 4: Official Uniform for Students/Referees

- First whistle, announcer will announce the competitor name.

Articles 7: Rules for Valari Throw

- Valari will be provided by organizing committee
- Competitors can select their own choice of Valari types (except final match)
- Competitors can throw their Valari 100 / 200 / 300 metres circle depends upon their convenient
- 5 times chance will be provided for each competitors to throw the Valari from the competition area
- Team Valari, team consist of 10 members (7 main Valari players & 3 Substitute Players)
- 4 / 6 / 10 marks will be given to competitors
- Thrown Valari returns to competitors by catching Valari 10 marks will be awarded
- Thrown Valari fall inside competition area 6 marks will be awarded
- Thrown Valari fall outside of competition area 4 marks will be awarded
- Thrown Valari is not return Zero mark will be awarded
- Final match, organizing committee will be providing Valari with their own choice.

Articles 8: Rules for Valari Forms

- The “points system” will be used for all Valari Form sevents, with the total score being announced on the completion of the Valari Forms.
- Competitors can choose to perform any Valari Forms from various martial arts; there will be no compulsory Valari Forms
- Separate Valari Forms Event will be conducted for Individual Weapon (Silambam stick, Maru, Aruval, Panthukol, Savuku, Vall, Surul Kaththi, Sedikuchi, Kobudo Weapons, Other country special weapons etc)
- The following basic points must be measured in each performance of a Valari Forms :
 - Valari Forms sequence.
 - Control of power.
 - Control of tension and contraction.
 - Control of speed and rhythm.
 - Direction of movements.

- The mark system for Valari Forms performance as follows:
 - 5.0 to 8.0 or 7.0 to 9.0
 - **Disqualification**, if the competitor stops the Valari Forms or incorrect performance.
 - **Disqualification**, if the competitor loses balance completely and/or falls.

Articles 9: Rules for Valari Fight

- The “points system” will be used for all Valari fights, with the total score being announced on the completion of the Valari fight
- Their own fighting style can be followed
- MANDATORY SAFETY EQUIPMENT
 - **Foot Pad:** Foot Pad is compulsory for all students when time of competition (Fight). Foot Pad should be made in rubber or sponge. Note: Without this protection the competition will not be undertaken by any countries.



- **Male and Female Groin Guard:** Groin Guard is compulsory for all students when time of competition (Fight). Groin Guard protects the competitor’s lower abdomen. Note: Without this protection the competition will not be undertaken by any countries.

- **SCORING AREAS**

- Attacks are limited to the following areas:
 - a) Side Hand (Semi Touch)
 - b) Back (but excluding the shoulders) (Semi Touch)
 - c) Leg (Semi Touch)
- ONRU (ஒன்று) SCORE: In scoring, it must be noted that an ONRU (ஒன்று) is worth one point.
- To score an ONRU, a technique must meet the following criteria.
 - a) Abdomen Level Semi Touch Strike
 - b) Side Hand Level Semi Touch Strike
 - c) Back Level Semi Touch Strike (but excluding the shoulders)
 - d) Leg level Semi Touch Strike
- IRANTU (இரண்டு) SCORE: In scoring, it must be noted that an IRANTU is worth 2 point. To score an IRANTU, a technique must meet the following criteria.
 - a) Two Side Hand (Semi Touch Same Time)
 - b) Two Back (but excluding the shoulders) (Semi Touch Same Time)
 - c) Two Leg (Semi Touch Same Time)

- “வளரியை உருவாக்கியவனும், வீசியவனும், அதை இந்த மண்ணை விட்டு மறைய செய்தவனும் கள்ளனே”.
- Holding the Heavy tip of the weapon and rolling it over the shoulder and quickly throwing it toward the target, it will hit the target and return to the thrower. A wonderful weapon that can attack the enemy and reach the thrower. The skilled thrower must be very careful when the Weapon returns to him. - பொருள்: யானையின் முறத்தைப் போன்ற செவியை மறைவிட மாய்க் கொண்டு பாய்ந்து மாறுபாடு செய்த புலியைச் சினந்து, மறம் பொருந்திய நூற்றுவர் தலைவனான துரியோதனனைத் தொடையில் உள்ள உயிரைப் போக்குகின்ற வீமனைப் போன்று, தன் நீண்ட கொம்பின் கூர்மையான முனையினால் குத்தி, புலியின் மார்பைப் பிளந்து பகைமை நீங்கிய யானை, அது மல்லரின் மறத்தை அழித்த திருமால் போல் கல் உயர்ந்த அகன்ற சாரலில் தன் சுற்றத்துடனே திரியும்.

- “பொன்னிமயக் கோட்டுப் புலிபொறித்து மண்ணாண்டான் மன்னன் வளவன் மதிற்புகார் வாழ்வேந்தன்; மன்னன் வளவன் மதிற்புகார் வாழ்வேந்தன் பொன்னந் திகிரிப் பொருபடையா னென்பரால்”
- பொருள்: சோழ மன்னன் பொன்னால் செய்த அழகிய வளரி என்னும் போர்ப்படையை உடையவன்
- இவ்வளரியானது வேட்டைக் கருவியாகவும் பிறரைத் தாக்கும் கருவியாகவும் சங்க காலத்தில் பயன்படுத்தி வந்துள்ளனர்.
- 3) # நடுகல் கல்வெட்டில்
- கூடலூரைச் சேர்ந்தவர்கள் ஆனிரையைக் கவர்ந்து செல்ல முயன்ற போது அந்தவன் என்பவன் ஆனிரையை மீட்டு அந்தப் பூசலில் இறந்து போன செய்தி குறிப்பிடப்பட்டுள்ளது. வைகை அணைக்கட்டுக்கு அருகிலுள்ள கூடலூர்ப் பகுதியில் ஆனிரை கவரும் கள்ளர் குலத்தவர்கள் வாழ்ந்து வந்துள்ளனர். புறநானூறு பாடலில் ‘மணம் நாறு மார்பின் மறப்போர் அகுதை குண்டு நீர் வரைப்பின் கூடல்’ என்று உள்ளது. கூடல் நகர் ஆட்சி செய்த அகுதை என்ற குறுநிலத் தலைவன் ‘பொன்புனை திகிரி’ (உலோகத்தாலான சக்ராயுதம்) என்ற ஆயுதத்தைக் கண நேரத்துக்குள், கண்டது உண்மையோ பொய்யோ என்று மருளும் வண்ணம், கண் பார்வைக்குத் தோன்றி மறைந்து விடக்கூடிய வகையில் விரைந்து செலுத்தவல்ல ஒரு வீரன் என்று புறநானூறு 233-ஆம் பாடலில் (‘அகுதைக் கண் தோன்றிய பொன்புனை திகிரியிற் பொய்யாகியரோ’) கூறப்பட்டுள்ளது.

எனும் அடியில் உள்ள எரிகோல் என்பது இங்கே வளரியைச் சுட்டுகின்றது.
வளரி என்பது குறுங்கோல் வளைதடி என்பதைக் “குறுங்கோலெறிந்த நெடுஞ்செவிக் குறுமுயல் (புறம்.339:4)” எனும் அடி குறிப்பிடுகின்றது.
- ஐங்குறுநூற்று
மாலை வெண்காழ் காவலர் வீச
நறும்பூம் புறவின் ஒடுங்குமுயல் இரியும் (ஐங்குறு.421:1-2)
வெண்காழென்றது மாலைக்காலத்து முயலெறியும் தடியை என்னும் வளரியாகிய வளைதடியாகும். இவ்வடியில் ‘காவலர்’

எனும் சொல்லினை ஆராய்ந்து நோக்குகையில் காவலர் என்பார் ஊர்க்காவலை மேற்கொண்டவராவார்.

- பிரிட்டிஷ் தொல்லியல் நிபுணர் ராபர்ட் புரூஸ் ஃபுட் அவர்கள் கள்ளரின் மணமகள் மற்றும் மணமகன் குடும்பங்களுக்கு இடையில் வளரி பரிமாற்றம் செய்யப்பட்டது என்றும் வளைதடியை அனுப்பிப் பெண்ணைக் கொண்டு வரும் வழக்கமும் இவர்களிடையே இருந்துள்ளது என்றும் திருமணத்திற்கு முன் வளைதடியை இருவீட்டாரும் மாற்றிக் கொள்வதும் உண்டு என்றும் கூறுகிறார்.
- புதுக்கோட்டை மன்னர்கள் எப்போதும் தங்கள் ஆயுதக்கிடங்கில் வளரி ஆயுதங்களை இருப்பு வைத்திருந்தனர். புதுக்கோட்டை மன்னர்களிடம் வளரி படை என்று தனி படை இருந்தது.
- சின்ன மருது காளையார்கோவிலின் கோபுரத்தை பெரிதாக கட்டியபோது வைத்தியலிங்க தொண்டைமான் அழைத்து கோபுரம் எப்படி என கேட்க இவர் ஒரு பனைமரம் அளவே உள்ளது என வேடிக்கையாக கூறினார். அதற்க்கு மருது என்ன பனைமரம் அளவா எப்படி சொல்கிறீர்கள் என வினா எழுப்ப. ஒரு வளரியை வாங்கி தான் பனைமரம் அளவு வளரி வீசுவேன் என வைத்தியலிங்க தொண்டைமான் வளரியை கோபுரத்தின் மேல் வீசி அந்த கோபுரத்தை தாண்டி வீசி எறிந்து காட்டினார் என ஒரு சம்பவம் தெரிவிக்கின்றது.
- தளசிங்க மாலையில் சேதுபதிகள் முற்காலத்து எட்டன் எனப் பெயர் கொண்ட ஒருவனோடு வளரி போர் புரிந்து அவன் தலையையே தம் வீரக்கழலில் அணிந்து கொண்டனர் எனும் செய்தியைக் கூறுகின்றது.
- “விஜய சேதுபதி (கி.பி.1710-1725) மன்னர் தனது மகள் அகிலாண்டேஸ்வரியைச் சிவகங்கைக்கு மணமுடித்து அனுப்பி வைத்தபோது சீர்களில் ஒன்றாகத் தம் குலமரபு ஆயுதமான வளரியையும் அனுப்பி வைத்ததாகக் கல்வெட்டு இதழில் குறிப்பிடப்பட்டுள்ளது (தமிழக ஆய்வுக் கட்டுரைகள், தொகுதி II, ப.43).
- கள்ளர்கள் ஆங்கிலேயருக்கு எதிரான போரில் வளரியைப் பயன்படுத்தியதாக எட்கர் தர்ஸ்டன் பதிவு செய்துள்ளார். வளரியைக் கண்டு ஆங்கிலேயர்கள் மிகவும் அஞ்சினார்கள் என்றும் இதனாலேயே போர் முடிந்ததும் கர்னல் அக்னியு சிவகங்கைப் பகுதியில் பத்தாயிரம் வளரிகளைக் கைப்பற்றியதாகவும் சென்னைப்படை வரலாறு தெரிவிக்கின்றது (தமிழக ஆய்வுக் கட்டுரைகள், தொகுதி I), ப.40).
- ஆங்கிலேயத் தளபதி கர்னல் வெல்த் என்பவர் (1795இல்) சின்னமருதுவிடம் வளரி வீசும் பயிற்சியினைக் கற்றுக்கொண்டதாகக் குறிப்பிட்டுள்ளார். வளரியை பயன்படுத்தி ஆங்கிலேயர்களுடன் மருது சகோதரர்கள் சண்டையிட்டார்கள்.

- கி.பி.1915 இல் மதுரை மாவட்டத்தில் கொண்டு வரப்பெற்ற குற்றச்சட்டத்தை எதிர்த்துப் பிறமலைக் கள்ளர் சமுதாயம் கி.பி.1921-
இல் கிளர்ந்தெழ உசிலம்பட்டி வட்டம் பெருங்காம நல்லூரில் பெருங்கிளர்ச்சி வெடித்தது. அப்போது நடந்த துப்பாக்கிச் சூட்டில் பலர் இறந்தனர். இக்கிளர்ச்சியின்போது இம்மக்கள் பயன்படுத்திய ஆயுதம் வளரியாகும். இதன் காரணமாக இவ்வாயுதத்தைப் பயன்படுத்த ஆங்கில அரசு தடை விதித்தது. வீடுகளில் வளரி வைத்திருந்தால் அவர்களைக் குற்றவியல் தண்டனைக்கு உட்படுத்தினர். எனவே இதனை வழிபாட்டிற்குரிய பொருள்களுள் ஒன்றாகக் கோயில்களில் வைத்துப் பாதுகாத்தனர் (தமிழ் ஆய்வுக் கட்டுரைகள் தொகுதி I, மணிமாறன், 2016, ப.41).
- வளரியைப் பூமராங் எனும் பெயரில் ஆஸ்திரேலியப் பழங்குடி மக்களான அபோர்ஜினியர்கள் பயன்படுத்தி வருவதாகச் கூறுகின்றன. ஆனால் அதற்கு முன்பாகவே தமிழ் நாட்டில் பயன்படுத்தப்பட்டது. திருநெல்வேலி மாவட்டம் ஆதிச்சநல்லூரில் அகழ்வாய்வின் மூலம் இரண்டு மண்டை ஓடுகள் கண்டெடுக்கப்பட்டன. அவ்விரண்டு மண்டை ஓடுகளை ஆராய்ந்த அறிஞர்கள் திராவிடரும் அபோர்ஜினியரும் சேர்ந்து வாழ்ந்துள்ளனர் என்ற முடிவினைக் கருதியுள்ளனர். மேலும் இங்குக் கண்டெடுத்த மண்டை ஓடுகளில் ஒன்று திராவிடருக்கும் மற்றொன்று ஆஸ்திரேலியப் பழங்குடிகளின் முன்னோருக்கும் உரியது என ஜி.எலியட் ஸ்மித் கூறியுள்ளார்.
